Accessibility Information

- There are safe, walking and cycling routes to Heron School, the number 2 bus stops near the school entrance and the number 8 bus stops on Abbeymead Avenue at the Turmut Hoer, about 15 minutes walk from the school so we encourage you to walk, cycle or use public transport if possible;
- There is some parking at the school site for those who have to drive
- Heron School is fully accessible, being step-free and with disabled-access toilets
- We will have a small room where parents can sit to feed babies or take children with SEND to sit quietly or spend time in the sensory tent
